(C) Print Media Advertising

Advertisements that ran in the November and December issues of the San Angelo Family Magazine stated the school's nondiscrimination policy. This magazine is free and is distributed to hospitals and other public places within the community for general public access. A copy of the advertisement which ran in December, 2003 is enclosed with the application packet.

(D) TV Advertising

TV commercials, which ran in December 2003 and January 2004, included the school's nondiscrimination policy. A printed copy of the commentary of these ads is enclosed with the application packet. A video copy of the TV advertisement can be sent should it be needed for your review.
